Frederick County Business and Industry Cabinet

The Frederick County Executive is soliciting letters of interest from individuals to serve on the 15-member Frederick County Business and Industry Cabinet (BIC).

The BIC will serve as an advisory board to the County Executive on matters related to sustainable and inclusive economic and workforce development, including strategic planning, marketing, and business recruitment, retention, and expansion. The BIC will also provide a forum for business leaders and government officials to share ideas, solutions, and creative approaches to business and workforce topics and issues facing Frederick County.

The membership shall include 15 members representing one of the following categories:

- 1) Resident of Frederick County;
- 2) Majority owner of a Frederick County business;
- 3) Executive at a corporation with a physical location in Frederick County; or
- 4) Representative of an institution of higher education in Frederick County.

The membership shall include two (2) ex-officio members: the Chief Financial Officer of Frederick County and the President & CEO of the Frederick County Chamber of Commerce.

The membership shall reflect the diversity of Frederick County, including representatives of Frederick County's key industry sectors (agriculture, craft beverage, data centers, life science and biotech, manufacturing, tech), and include representatives of associated sectors (banking and finance, law, real estate, non-profits). The membership shall include representatives of major employers and small businesses. The members will serve two-year terms.
